

## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS - ASSEMBLY

## **GENERAL NOTES**

Assembly must be carried out strictly in accordance with the assembly instructions. Incorrect assembly can lead to a safety risk. All components must be assembled professionally by trained personnel.

Please note: Fittings and connectors for the individual components may be contained in the fittings package supplied. Before assembly, please ensure that all the parts are included and, if necessary, replace or add to them.

When installing the carcases, ensure that they cannot tip over or become displaced at a later stage. The cabinet hangers supplied must be used.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR FIXING TO AND TOGETHER WITH THE SURROUNDINGS

Some fittings, for example heavy-duty mounting elements, are supplied without fixing material. The suitability of the wall / ceiling must be checked to ensure that the fixing devices are able to withstand the forces that will be present. Suitable material must be procured and incorporated in accordance with the nature of the wall.

If wall mounting is not possible (for example with an island solution), the cabinets must be fixed to the floor with the anti-tip device. To prevent tipping, the pass-through base unit must be firmly anchored to the floor in or on cooking islands. Additionally, an adequate connection to other furniture parts / cabinets / worktops must be realised with the connecting screws supplied. Please make allowances for underfloor heating or similar! The floor fixing material is not included in the package! The fixing material must be provided by the customer themselves after checking the nature of the floor! Fixing the pass-through base unit to the floor is the sole responsibility of the customer and is recommended by Beckermann Küchen GmbH in all cases! If the cabinets are not installed correctly, this can result in serious damage to property and personal injury.

Side cabinets must be fixed to the wall with a metal bracket to prevent them from tipping over. Fixing the side cabinets in particular is strongly recommended, as tipping can result in serious damage to property and personal injury.

Following completion of assembly, the marking for placing on the market (label) must be affixed in a suitable place (visible, but inconspicuous).
